The research consisted in the gathering of EU secondary law and case-law of the European Court of Justice (ECJ) aimed at fulfilling the Project rdpress.com/2018/11/e-nact-"e-Learning National Active Charter Training (e-NACT)", which is co-funded by the European Commission (DG Justice, JUST-AG-2016-04). The main purpose of the research is to collect and classify EU secondary law and ECJ's case-law concerning the rights of the child. The research has been cross-sectoral, considering relevant EU law and case-law in fields such as the free movement of minors that are EU citizens or family members of EU citizens, immigration and asylum law, judicial cooperation in the civil and criminal fields, as well as police cooperation.
